REQUEST FOR EDUCATIONAL CREDITS EARNED AT NON-PSIA-AASI FUNCTIONS.

In order to receive credit for a non-PSIA-AASI event, members may request such credit by completing a Request Form found on the NI website and sending with a processing fee of \$40 to the Northern Intermountain Office. Northern Intermountain members may receive no more than 12 CEUs for non-PSIA clinics every 4 seasons. Full Day = 6+ hours = 6 CEUs Half Day = 3-5 hours = 3 CEUs
